A queer, white, anti-racist social change agent with a twinkle in her eye, Evangeline has over 18 years of community building and organizational development experience. Evangeline facilitates change processes, workshops and retreats to sustain leaders on a path towards intentionality, purpose, and impact. After earning a Masters' degree in educational policy studies, Evangeline has facilitated transformation in public health settings, social justice coalitions and non-profits, as well as schools and institutions of higher education.

As the National LGBTQ Task Force's Leadership Programs Director for 10 years, Evangeline designed and led programs for 100's of staff and volunteer leaders from same sex marriage and anti-discrimination campaigns and LGBTQ organizations across the country. In 2016, Evangeline co-created a workshop for white women to build antiracism into their everyday lives; today, Web Are Finding Freedom is a network of 1200 alumni. Evangeline turned her TV off in 1984 and enjoys making art and walking around.
